MISSIONS & OUTREACH

Pastor Beau Linker has been the Area Director of the Stanly & Montgomery County Chapter of Fellowship of Christian Athletes since September of 2020. Under his leadership the ministry has grown by leaps and bounds. There are student huddles in almost every middle and high school in Stanly County. On Thursday nights over 175 students in the County attend SK8 City for fellowship and prayer.

This is a large, diverse gathering of students. The best part of the ministry is that we are reaching the unchurched with the gospel and may be the only opportunity that some of these kids have to hear

about the love of Christ. Our growth is currently outpacing our funding! Over the last year dozens of young people have given their lives to Christ because of the faithful ministry of FCA.

In March of 2003, I did my first medical mission trip to India. On the last day I had the privilege of meeting Koshy Baby and his wife Joicy. They talked about their faith and how they act that out personally and in ministry. He told me his God was a God who said the just would live by faith.

At that time Koshy and Joicy had a small school of about 350 children. His dream, however, would be to give each one of these kids something to eat every day. Many of the kids may only eat once every 2-3 days. While at

school, kids would regularly faint or have seizures.

When I heard this, I knew I had to do something. The Bible says in 1 John 3:17 that whoever has this world's goods and sees his brother in need and shuts up his heart from him, how can the love of God be in him? That same year Koshy was able to come to our small country church and, while he was speaking, the Holy Spirit started moving on our hearts. Spontaneously people been coming to the church, dropping off financial gifts trying to help. In that one day, because of the move of God on our hearts, we were able to feed the children at that school for an entire year.

Aaron's Hands ministries begain from that moment. Scripture tells us in Exodus 17 that as long as Aaron held the hands of Moses up the Israelites would win the battle. It is my job to hold up the hands of Koshy and what he is doing in India with prayer, finances, mission visits, and holding clinics to support the local pastors in their communities. Koshy and Joicy are operating over eleven schools now with over five thousand children! More than two hundred churches have been planted in the last decade out of Koshy's church. The children we first worked with are now computer engineers, teachers, and pastors.


