INTRODUCTION & INSTRUCTIONS

WE PRAY TO BE FORMED BY GOD. TAKE A MOMENT AND QUIET YOUR HEAD, HEART AND SPIRIT. OPEN YOURSELF TO HEARING FROM GOD AND THEN BEGIN WITH THESE PRAYERS EACH DAY. THIS IS THE WORK OF SLOWING DOWN AND POSTURING YOURSELF TO HEAR FROM GOD.

FIRST WORDS IN PRAYER

In the name of the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit. Amen.

O Lord, open my lips And my mouth will declare your praise. (*Psalm 51:15*) For your inexpressible gift; Thanks be to God. (*2 Corinthians 9:15*)

Glory be to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit. As it was, is now, and forever will be. Gracious, Blessed, Father, Son and Spirit. Amen.

CONFESSION AND DECLARATION

Blessed is the one whose transgressions are forgiven, whose sins are covered.

Blessed is the one whose sin the Lord does not count against them and in whose spirit is no deceit.

Guidance for those who govern and those who are governed. For peace and justice.

For the growth and deep rooted cultivation of unity and hospitality at AFA. For our pastor, board, leadership team.

SATURDAY: the witness of Christians

That the church may grow inwardly in discipleship and outwardly through evangelism of the lost.

PRAYER OF GRACE


