Pray for these weekly needs:

Wisdom in reaching out with God's love through our various vocations, local businesses and medical missions. Business owners in the community, doctors, nurses, civil servants.

Tuesday: the church at home and at school

For homes and schools. All of our county schools, charter and
private schools, college and universities.

Wednesday: the church serving the needy
The people who reach out regularly, for the needs of the
community. All of our local and regional outreach
partnerships: Pregnancy Resource Center, Stanly Christian
Ministry, Convoy of Hope.

Pray for these weekly needs:

Thursday: the church in our nation and world
Guidance for those who govern and those who are governed.
For peace and justice. Local, state, and national officials and servants

Friday: AFA's own fellowship

For the growth and deep-rooted cultivation of unity and hospitality at AFA. For our pastor, board, and leadership team.

Saturday: the witness of Christians

That the church may grow inwardly in discipleship and outwardly through evangelism of the lost; All of our supported missionaries.

SLOWING DOWN AND SITTING WITH JESUS.

Take several minutes to sit in silence.

If you need to say something or think something, say or think in Jesus's name. Maybe set a timer or an alarm, but take several minutes to be still, silent, breathe, and just BE with Jesus.

PRAYER WITH OPEN HANDS

Lord Jesus, speak gently in my silence. When the loud noises of my surroundings and the loud inner noises of my fears keep pulling me away from you, help me to trust that you are still there even when I am unable to hear you. Give me ears to listen to your small, soft voice- Let that loving voice be my guide.

CLOSING PRAYERS

These prayers are an appropriate ascent from the slower, more contemplative prayer that we've just prayed. Pray these as you wrap up this time of prayer.
